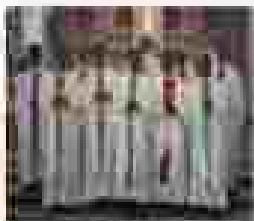
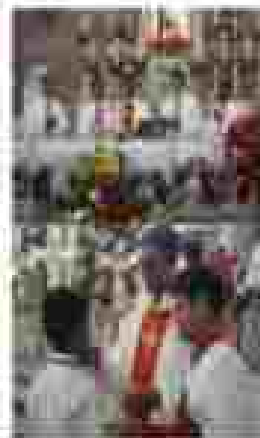


Attitudes toward people with mental illness improved among DASH meeting attendees, according to a study published in the *Journal of Community Psychology*. The study, conducted by researchers at the University of California, San Diego, found that participants who attended DASH meetings showed significant improvements in their attitudes toward people with mental illness compared to those who did not attend. The researchers also found that participants who attended DASH meetings showed significant improvements in their knowledge about mental illness and their willingness to help people with mental illness.

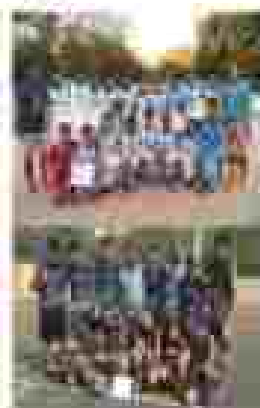
The study was conducted over a period of 12 weeks. Participants were recruited from a variety of sources, including community organizations, social media, and direct mail. They were then randomly assigned to either a DASH meeting group or a control group. The DASH meetings were held weekly and focused on providing information about mental illness, sharing personal experiences, and discussing ways to reduce stigma. The control group did not attend any meetings. At the end of the 12-week period, participants completed a survey that measured their attitudes, knowledge, and willingness to help people with mental illness.

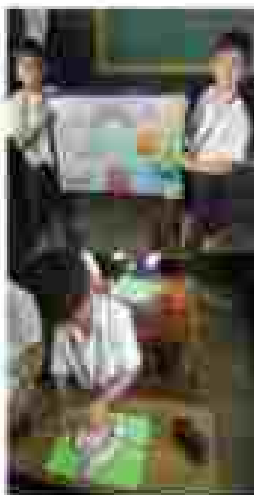


Figure 1: Students working on a mathematical project.
